



Waste Disposal Chutes

– how they work

At the bottom of each stairwell there is a “storage valve room” (the initial holding area for the household waste). Waste bags remain in the pipe just above the valv for a few hours (so called intermediate storage) before moving on. There are two containers, situated at Kungsklippan 14 and Kungsbro Strand 19C. They start up a few times a day. The storage valves in each stairwell then open and all the household waste is sucked through large pipes and culverts to these containers. The speed is 70km/h so it is important that the bag can take the strain. Sensors in the chutes notice when there is an obstruction and the plant is closed down. We have to live with the stoppage until staff can find the fault. The containers are emptied a few times a week.

For household waste only!

The bag must be sealed. No loose ends.

The chute is blocked?

**Walk/take the lift 1 or 2 floors up
to dispose of the waste there.**



Pizza packing must be ripped into pieces. All waste must be put into bags and the bags must be tied up.
